BJHS Alumni Association Scholarship Criteria

The Brownville Junction High School Alumni Association currently awards five scholarships annually, some for high school seniors; some for college students.

These are all awarded on the merit system.

Applicants must have at least an 85/B-/2.70 average and be a full time student to be eligible for any scholarship.

All children/grandchildren and step-children/step-grandchildren of BJHS Alumni Association members in good standing are eligible. Members in good standing have paid their dues for the current year (the year prior to the application deadline).

Deceased members in good standing will be moved to a memorial roll and their children/grandchildren will automatically be eligible for scholarships in any year.

All scholarships are awarded for the second (spring) semester.

In the event a scholarship recipient does not return to school for the second semester, that scholarship will be re-awarded to the applicant with the next highest grade point average.

If any scholarships are not awarded due to lack of qualified applicants in any category, the applicant with the next highest grade point average in each category will be awarded through a lottery. The Margaret Law Scholarship will not be awarded if there are no qualified candidates majoring in the medical field in accordance with the stipulations for this scholarship.

Be sure your parent/grandparent is identified on the application and that their dues are paid for the current year.
