Waste must be placed at the edge of the road in rodent proof and leak proof containers with tight covers or in plastic bags. 55-gallon drums may **NOT** be used. Waste must be put at the roadside no later than 6:30 A.M.

Any ordinary household waste is acceptable. Items for collection cannot be greater than six feet in length and not exceed approximately 70 pounds in weight. If more than three cardboard boxes are put out, they must be **broken down** and **stacked**, preferably tied. Tires may be picked up curbside in quantities of 3; rims must be removed and no larger than 16".
